# Who is eligible?



## Help is available to individuals with a Masonic connection, meaning:

- Freemasons under the United Grand Lodge of England (UGLE)
- Dependants of a Freemason under UGLE – usually a wife, partner, widow or child
- A limited range of assistance is also available to grandchildren and other relatives of a Freemason under UGLE

## What help is available?

A wide range of help is available from Masonic organisations for financial, healthcare and family related needs.

### Financial

- Essential daily living costs
- Funeral bills
- Minor home repairs
- Hardship faced following an accident, redundancy, or other personal crisis

### Healthcare

- Medical treatment
- Dental treatment
- Mobility aids and essential home adaptations
- Respite care

### Family - Children in full time education or younger

- Maintenance allowances and welfare support
- Support for children and young people with severe disabilities
- Educational costs such as IT equipment, course materials, school uniforms and travel
- Scholarships and accommodation for students and postgraduates
- Grants to support young people with exceptional talent in music, sport or the performing arts

### Family - Older people (65+)

- Care homes - nursing, residential and dementia care
- Care advice
- Holidays

Eligibility for assistance usually depends on the income and savings of the individual and other relevant criteria. For detailed and up to date information please contact Freemasonry Cares.
